

Application Procedure: Joint Academic 2+2/3+2/1+2+1 Environment programs

How to apply: Applications for **September (Fall) 2023** (CODE **WGG**) and 1+2+1 (CODE **WXA**) entries are open until **March 25, 2023** for the Geography & Environmental Management and Geomatics programs.

- Applications for 3+2 **January (Winter) 2023** (CODE **WET – NUFE students only**) entry are open until **January 12, 2023** for the Environment & Business program
- **Carefully complete the online Application for Admission at:**

- Set up an account and then select the appropriate program you are applying for by choosing “**University of Waterloo - International Agreements Application.**”
- **Make sure you select the right program entry code:**

- Please provide a current, valid email address as we will be communicating with you throughout the application process through email. Please do NOT use any qq.com email addresses.

The total application fee is \$85.00 in Canadian funds. Payable to the Ontario Universities' Application Centre upon completing your online application.

International Payment Options:

- Credit/Debit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express, VISA Debit or Debit MasterCard).
- Online banking through selected Canadian banks and credit unions only. This normally takes 2-5 business days to process. You must make all payments in Canadian funds.
- Flywire allows you to pay Canadian dollar fees in the currency of your choice. It provides a simple and secure way of initiating a payment electronically. This may take 2-5 business days to process.

Required Documents at time of Application (to complete the Application Process):

Required documents for your application for the students that are coming to University of Waterloo for the fall term 2023, must be received by Waterloo no later than **March 30, 2023**. NUFE students that come to Waterloo for fall term 2024 - more details to follow).

- A current official university transcript with a certified English language translation. If your transcript does NOT indicate your current course enrollment you will need to include a letter (preferably from your advisor) listing your current courses. You must arrange for official documents to be sent directly to the University by the issuing institution in a signed and sealed envelope.
- A copy of your official Senior High School Graduation Diploma and official Chinese University Entrance Exam (Gaokao), in signed and sealed envelopes.
- A copy of your language test results: CET4 & 6, TOEFL or IELTS if available.
- You can upload unofficial documents directly to the system (if your 2nd year grades are not available by the deadline, please submit them as soon as possible)
- A printed copy of your completed application form with your institution's nomination signature.

NOTE: We cannot make a decision if we do not have all your documents.
